Miami dade: So can extensions if mutual be extended to all evaluations? Also, what will the impact be on Indicator 11 ?

Andrea Wallace, FIMC-VI: The assessments to determine the impact of those visual disabilities is hindered. Those assessments have many face to face components

Mason: Our district is providing plexiglass screen guards, masks, gloves etc so that we can conduct face to face evaluations. What are your thoughts?

Mary Wolf: What is everyone doing about evaluating DD students who have turned 6?

Patti Vickers, Osceola: How do we justify using RtI data that will be at least 6 months old if not older once the evaluation can be completed and the staffing can occur?

Patti Vickers, Osceola: What will happen with Indicator 11 for the 2019-2020 school year?

Miami dade: you reference standardized procedures for validity-- need more details

Jamie Brennan: Duval County - Do you suggest we gather information directly from students and families about specific impacts of COVID-19? If so, what kinds of information should we ask for?

Lara Manalo - Baker: Earlier I thought he said the SLD rule would ALLOW for timeline extensions?

Troy Radford- Volusia County Schools: How do we send in a question for Dr. Wheeler....

Maggie Dean-Hillsborough: Has there been any further discussion about extending DD eligibility beyond the age of 6?

Kari: None of these tests are normed for kids in crisis. is there any information about that coming in?

Lara Manalo - Baker: To clarify.... Is the guidance to establish a new deadline, and then we are bound by that new deadline? (versus an open-ended extension)

Troy Radford- Volusia County Schools: lol...oh...once we start face to face evaluations again, does the timeline/60 day "clock" start up again? For example, when we shut down we were on day 30 of an eval timeline...once we have a data to resume F2F would the clock start back up? Like day 31....

Troy Radford- Volusia County Schools: I would LOVE extension of DD!!!

Sara Sanders 2: @Troy - I think David said earlier that the state is trying to get federal approval for a new timeline extension

Troy Radford- Volusia County Schools: Thank you Sara!

shoshanah mercado: Concerned for secondary students who have been in the process for some time but lost intervention time. Will those 3 months negate all of the previous months/years of interventions? Can we just pick up where we left off?

Julie Sloan: Meeting CDC Safety Guidelines may not mean we can meet Test Standardization rules....6ft distance is not appropriate for test administration.

Troy Radford- Volusia County Schools: Julie...i was just going to ask...I see some have face shields or clear partitions....

Sonia Howley: If a DD student has an IEP with a secondary disability, DD could be dropped and continue the IEP as written just under the secondary disability, with a meeting to decide the need for re-evaluation once school re-opens. If there is no secondary- Only DD is a tricky matter for sure.

Geri Ellis: Am I understanding correctly that we have 60 days to complete an initial evaluation but that the eligibility determination meeting does not need to be held within that 60 days?

Carrie Rullo: Students could potentially return with more significant deficits than when we transitioned to remote learning. All data is important but we are guiding our teams really need to review updated data when they return to ensure they are addressing areas of current needs

Herring-Cayasso-Duval: Duval county is using face shields, mask, gloves and plexiglass partitions

Jonathan Chasin: Pasco is as well

Audrey Hollinger: What about instances where parents do not respond to attempts to contact? Would this be considered "parent did not present child for evaluation" when considering timelines?

Rengin Pecci: That is a good question Audrey.

Freda Deaguilera: For the LD rule you are mentioning, would that apply to language impairment as well? You can not staff a student unless there is MTSS.

Anthony Davis: Freda, I believe he stated that mutual extension for the 60 day timeline is for the SLD program only.
